TO CONSIDER

1. What stood out to you as you listened to the message today? What did you learn about God....about yourself?

4. One of the ways in which the people of Israel were considered unfaithful to God was in their tithes and offerings — things that belonged to God (Malachi 3:8). They were giving Him what they didn't want (blind/lame/sick animals for sacrifice). He considered it "robbery." In Romans 12:1, you are called to offer up your whole self as a living sacrifice to God. In what ways could you be robbing God without realizing it?

5. What's one practical step you can take to make what you've learned today a reality in your life?
