Questions

TO CONSIDER

1. If we are going to look to Christ as our example and share the gospel as He did (“doing good” and sharing the good news of the gospel) what will this look like in our culture and context?

2. Recently, COVID-related stress has created fear and anxiety in our culture. What are some ways we can share and live the gospel as we interact with those around us?

3. Our understanding of “separation” can sometimes result in segregation. What does it mean to live in the world without being of the world (John 15:19)? How do we reconcile this truth with our Lord Jesus being a friend of sinners (Matthew 11:19, Luke 7:34)?

TO CONSIDER

4. How important is building a relationship with someone to the process of sharing the gospel with them? Discuss practical ways we can build a relationship in order to cultivate the soil of a person's heart while planting the seeds of the gospel.

5. When evangelizing, we engage in spiritual warfare. As believers, we can unintentionally hinder evangelism through conflict, discouragement, and division; how can we unitedly seek to be strong in the Lord, caring for the spiritual well-being of our sisters, while sharing the gospel?

6. What resources have you used to share the gospel with your family? What spiritual practices have you found most effective in communicating the gospel to an unbelieving spouse or child? How can we cultivate our children's desire to evangelize?

TO CONSIDER

7. Although we are all commissioned to evangelize, life limitations or seasons of life may affect our personal evangelism. Even if limited, how can you use your unique personality, skills, and resources to support sharing the gospel?

8. Do you have a specific evangelism prayer request for your small group? (e.g., the salvation of a friend or family member, growth in your personal outreach)

9. For personal consideration: Based on the message and discussion, what practical ideas will you apply in your personal evangelism or how can you encourage evangelism in others?
